### **Yutaka IIMURA**

Yutaka Iimura is currently Senior Fellow and Visiting Professor at GRIPS. He joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan in 1969. After having served at the Japanese embassies in USSR, France, and the Philippines, he was appointed as the Minister for Political Affairs in the Embassy of Japan in the United States (1993-95), the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Indonesia (2002-06) and to France (2006-09).

In the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Tokyo, he served, among others, as Deputy Director-General for European Affairs (1997-99), Director-General for International Development (1999-2001) and Deputy-Minister for Administration (2001), Special Representative of the Government of Japan for the Middle East and Europe (2009-2014), and Special Envoy for Cooperation for Southeast Asia (2014-2016).

He taught also International relations as Visiting Professor at Tokyo University (Regional Studies) (1998-99) as well as at Tokyo University's Graduate School of Public Administration (2010-12).
